

## 1. Controller

The controller for processing your personal data on our website is Georg Brodbeck. You can find our contact information in the imprint.

## 2. General information on data processing

We collect and use personal data of our users only to the extent necessary to provide a functional website as well as our content and services. However, we also use third-party components, whose privacy conditions are beyond our control.

## 3. Anonymous Data Collection

As long as you do not create an account and log in, only anonymous statistics about the website visit are stored.

However, the following programming interfaces are queried for some functions:

- Leaflet (for displaying the 2D map)
- Google Fonts API (icons and fonts)
- MapTiler (satellite images and topo maps)
- ArcGis (satellite images and various maps)
- Google Maps API (location data, satellite imagery and topo maps)
- Cesium ION (terrain data)
- OpenTopoMap (topo maps)
- No personal data is transmitted to these providers. However, they may store your IP address or other metadata.

We reserve the right to add more map data providers at any time.

Moreover, we use the Google Maps API to display countries and place names on flights. When you create a scene, the first and last track point is always sent anonymously to the Google Maps API.

## 4. Personal Data

In the following situations, your data will be stored:

- Creating an account
- Logging in
- Creating a scene
- Editing a scene
- Viewing a scene
- Liking a scene
- Sending a message via the contact form

In each of these cases, the entered data, as well as a timestamp and the reference to the user profile, are stored.

Data is only shared with third parties as far as necessary for the functioning of the platform. Data is transmitted to the following third-party providers:

- Stripe, as a payment provider. To process a payment, we transmit the email address and the desired product to Stripe. Stripe may also create cookies. Stripe is responsible for the security of payment information. More information can be found in Stripe's privacy policy.
- MailerSend, for sending emails. To send emails for address confirmation, forgotten passwords, or newsletters, we work with MailerSend. Your email address, nickname, and the content of each email sent to you are transmitted to MailerSend. MailerSend is responsible for the security and protection of your data. More information can be found in the privacy policy of MailerSend.

## 5. Contact form and email contact

There is a contact form on our website, which can be used for electronic contact. If you take this option, the data entered in the input mask will be transmitted to us and stored.

If possible, do not use the email address provided in the imprint for contacting us, as it receives a lot of spam due to its public appearance, and thus genuine messages can sometimes get lost.

## 6. Rights of the data subject

You have the right:

- to information about the data we have stored about you.
- to correction, if we have stored incorrect data about you.
- to deletion, if you wish and the prerequisites for this are met.
- to restriction of processing, if the prerequisites for this are met.
- to data portability, if the prerequisites for this are met.
- to object to a certain data processing, if the prerequisites for this are met.

## 7. Data security

We use technical and organizational security measures to protect your data processed by us against manipulation, loss, destruction and against access by unauthorized persons. Our security measures are continuously improved in line with technological development.
